#### Guidelines for Choosing Books and Reading Tips

- You may read a play.
- You should read books that are age-appropriate, and that you feel comfortable recommending to fellow classmates.
- Choose books that you enjoy, but consider reading one book that is towards the upper end of your reading level.
- You keep several of your books in 7th grade. To this end, you may want to practice highlighting and annotating one book you read.



## Part II: The One-Pager Poster

For one of the four books you are required to read, create a poster-sized one-pager (I believe you did such an assignment for Ms. Howard this spring). This time, your one-pager must be poster-sized. The poster must be at least 14 x 22 inches. These boards often come in packs of three from office supply shops. Also, you will need access to these materials: pens, pencils, markers, crayons, and/or paint (anything you could use for drawing and coloring). If you are concerned about how you will access these items, please email me as soon as possible at [cmuro@stlukeschool.org](mailto:cmuro@stlukeschool.org).

**Poster Checklist:** Your one-pager poster must include the following elements:

- Write the **title** of the book and the **author's full name** somewhere on your poster.
- Select and copy a significant **quotation** from the book and **explain what it means**. Cite the page number. These may be computer generated.
- Draw **three images** from the book. Your images may be printed from a computer or cut out of a magazine.
- Under each image, write a **caption** that explains the image. Your captions may be quotations. Be sure to use quotation marks and cite page numbers if you do this. Your captions may also be written in your own words.
- Create a **border** using a **key quotation** from the book.
- Identify** and **write** what you believe to be the main **theme** of the book somewhere on your poster ([sample themes](#)).
- Copy** and **define two important words** from the book. Use **dictionary** definitions and include the **part of speech**.
- Quote a passage** from the book and explain **how you relate** to it.
- Explain **why a friend or family member** might want to read the book.
- Use **color and designs** to liven up your poster.
- Write **your full name** and **grade level (7)** on the bottom right hand corner of the front of the poster.
- Review** your poster with someone, ideally another rising 7th grader, making sure you've included all elements.
- It should take you **2-4 hours** to complete this project.
- Take a picture** of your poster.
- Email** it to both [cmuro@stlukeschool.org](mailto:cmuro@stlukeschool.org) and [eeisman@stlukeschool.org](mailto:eeisman@stlukeschool.org) **by August 31, 2020**.
- Bring your poster to Room 400 on the second day of school.
